A Note From the Rector

Last week in our weekly newsletter I quoted Howard Thurman, one of Dr. Martin Luther King's mentors. This week, I quote Dr. King himself. In his book, *Strength to Love*, Dr. King discusses the role of the church. He writes:

The church must be reminded that it is not the master or the servant of the state, but rather the conscience of the state. It must be the guide and the critic of the state, and never its tool. If the church does not recapture its prophetic zeal, it will become an irrelevant social club without moral or spiritual authority. If the church does not participate actively in the struggle for peace and for economic and racial justice, it will forfeit the loyalty of millions and cause [people] everywhere to say that it has atrophied its will. But if the church will free itself from the shackles of a deadening status quo, and, recovering its great historic mission, will speak and act fearlessly and insistently in terms of justice and peace, it will enkindle the imagination of [hu]mankind and fire the souls of people, imbuing them with a glowing and ardent love for truth, justice, and peace. [People} far and near will know the church as a great fellowship of love that provides light and bread for lonely travelers at midnight.

In today's gospel Jesus calls his first disciples. This week, think about how God is calling Christ Church and you as an individual.


