Music Director Search Update: Additionally, we have been busy with our search for a Music Director. Sandy Bakken, who is a professional recruiter, put together a process. Here is a brief outline:

- 1. Advertise in the greater SF Bay area (not nationwide).
- 2. Filter resumes and narrow down to 2-3 candidates.
- 3. Interview candidates with group from congregation and choir to see if a good fit.
- 4. Organ and piano skills assessment by Duane Soubirous and/or **Ed Jennings**
- 5. Rehearsal with choir and possibly a mock service audition. We interviewed two exceptional candidates this week. The next step is for the choir to assess the candidates. Please pray for this process as prayer does work and helps the process.
