

A Note from Your Rector

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Some new things are happening around Christ Church.

First, the Vestry will now be meeting on the third Sunday of the month following the 10 a.m. service. All are welcome to attend.

Second, on the second Sundays of the month starting February, we will have an alternative Rite III service at 10 a.m. You might be wondering what does that mean? What is that? In short, our Book of Common Prayer provides two services for Sunday Mornings. The more traditional one that we do on Sundays at 8 a.m. is called Rite I. The service we do at the 10 a.m. service is called Rite II. Each has its own language. One of the things that makes us Episcopalian is that we have the Book of Common Prayer. Thus, when you walk into any Episcopal Church anywhere the service should feel familiar because we all follow the liturgy set forth in the Book of Common Prayer.

The way we worship is one of the things that we hold in common with other Episcopal churches. The Book of Common Prayer, however, permits some flexibility in the way we worship. This is often referred to as Rite III even though the heading of it on page 400 simply calls it "An Order for Celebrating Holy Eucharist." It provides a general outline of what a service should contain without setting it out word for word—at least up until the Eucharistic prayers. It also limits its use so that we— as a single congregation stay in synch with and maintain our worship that we hold in common with the larger Episcopal Church and even the larger Anglican Communion.

In the coming year, we will be exploring in depth what it means to be a Christian; what it means to be part of the Anglican Communion; what is means to be an Episcopalian; and what it means to be part of Christ Church Portola Valley. In the meantime, you can expect the Second Sunday Rite III Service to be less formal and rigid and a little shorter. It will be more thematic, interactive and family friendly. We will invite kids of all ages to join and participate in that worship (although the nursery will still be available). Hopefully, it will encourage you to encounter and deepen your relationship with God and each other.
