After one of the pastors distributed shoe boxes to 400 children, the village chief was so moved by this expression of God's love that he gave his entire family permission to become Christians. He also provided land to build a church. Both children and adults there have now accepted Christ as their Lord and Savior. We at Christ Church, Presbyterian have the privilege of participating in this missions project! You will find prewrapped shoe boxes in the foyer ready to be filled and returned on October 30, November 6, and November 13.
