**Other Announcements**

**Global Hymn Sing** – Today, over 600,000 believers in almost 3,500 churches across 63 countries around the globe will be singing the missions hymn, "Jesus Shall Reign," in their worship services. This is the third year with singing various hymns together as an encouragement coordinated by hymn writer Keith Getty. It is an act of solidarity and support of global missions to the unreached. Eric Little, the great Scottish athlete who won a gold medal in the 1924 Paris Olympics was portrayed in the movie “Chariots of Fire.” Less than a year after the Olympics, Eric decided to go to China as a missionary. It caused quite a controversy with many in the UK not understanding such a decision. He was called deluded, a coward, treasonous, and in the newspapers a fool. While departing Waverly station in London to China, a journalist asked him to comment. His only response was to sing the first stanza of this powerful hymn; “Jesus shall reign where’er the sun does His successive journeys run; His kingdom stretch from shore to shore, till moons shall wax and wane no more.”
