### II. Thin–Exclusivity of Prayer

- One Gospel
- One Mediator—the Lord Jesus Christ (v. 5)
  - Sacrificial (v. 6) (John 10:18)

  - Satisfactory

Salvation could not have been done unless man paid what was owing to God for sin.
