Rev. Todd Erickson serves as Pastoral Executive at Second Presbyterian Church in Memphis, Tennessee. The great passions of Todd's life are The Lord Jesus Christ and His church, his wife of 25 years, Lynn, and his children, Ben (24), Zach (21) and Ellie (17). All that he does in life he does in light of these five passions! Prior to his current position, Todd served as student pastor for 25 years. In that role he was privileged to be a part of 26 different mission projects in nine different countries. The Lord used these projects to shape his thinking and to keep the command of Matthew 28:19 always at the forefront of his life. These experiences perfectly prepared him to be the leader of the Evangelism and Discipleship Team at Second where he and his team strive to create a culture of evangelism and discipleship; demonstrating through their lives what it means to "make the most of every opportunity."

Todd serves on the boards of new Hope Christian Academy, an urban, college preparatory elementary school, and the Presbyterian Day School, an evangelical, college preparatory elementary school for boys. He is also founder and director of The Edge Conference, a national conference dedicated to junior high students, where hundreds of students have come to know Christ.

Todd graduated from Covenant College with a degree in Biblical Studies and did graduate work at Reformed Theological Seminary in Charlotte, NC.

Dr. Louis & Anne Carter, our missionary speakers, serving under SIM, International and the Christian Medical and Dental Association. Louis is a surgeon specializing in plastic and hand surgery and Anne is an operating room registered nurse. They served for a number of years in Africa and now serve in an itinerant ministry teaching missionary and national doctors plastic, reconstructive and hand surgery and operating room procedures in mission hospitals. Dr. Carter received the Surgical Humanitarian Award from the American College of Surgeons in 2011, "in recognition of a veritable lifetime of service to the underserved; spanning nearly five decades, 20 countries and 74 mission trips. Dr. Carter has left a legacy of surgeons, nurses and other medical professionals who are equipped with the knowledge and skills to care for hand injuries, burn [injuries], cleft lips and palates, as well as other correctable debilitating conditions."
