## OUR PURPOSE

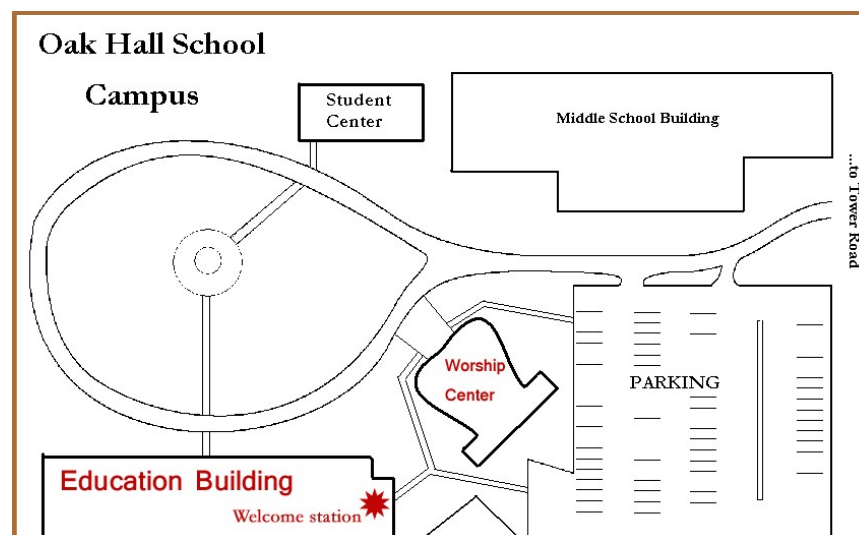
