### RE-ENROLLING & FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE APPLICATIONS

If you have not yet done so, please consider re-enrolling your child(ren) for next school year sooner than later. While the risk of not having space in any given class remains a slight risk, our projected budget is based on our expected enrollment numbers. We are able to much more clearly plan for staffing needs, technology tools, and other support services if we have a strong handle on estimated class sizes.

Many families apply for financial scholarship assistance each year by completing a TADS online application. This same application further qualified every applicant to receive funds from the Building Blocks Scholarship Fund managed by the Lutheran Foundation of Greater St. Louis. **The deadline for the Building Blocks scholarship was April 1.** As we review applications for the 2014-2015 school year, you can only be considered if you have a completed financial assistance application on file. If you believe that you may qualify for assistance, you are encouraged to get your application completed immediately so that you can be considered by both CCLS and the Building Blocks Fund for determined need. At this time, there is no assistance offered for children in our early childhood program, as it is limited to students entering grades K-8.

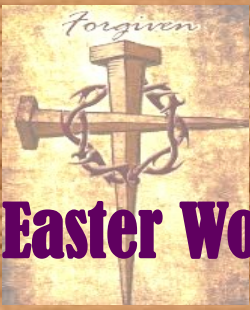
## Lutheran Day at Busch Stadium
