LENTEN QUIET DAY – Sponsored by the Centering Prayer Community – Saturday, February 24 – 8:30am-1:00pm. “Be still and know that I am God” (Psalm 46:10). Join us for a morning of meditations and exploration of contemplative prayer practices. We may think of prayer as thoughts or feelings expressed in words. But this is only one expression. In the Christian tradition, contemplative prayer is considered to be a gift of God. It is the opening of mind and heart – our whole being – to God, beyond thoughts, words, and emotions. Check-in, registration for small groups, and a light breakfast begins at 8:30am in Surface Hall and the first meditation begins in the Nave at 9:00am.
