LIVING WATERS FOR THE WORLD

Living Waters for the World (LWW) is a “global outreach ministry...that trains and equips mission teams to share the gift of clean water treatment systems with communities in need. The water treatment systems and related educational programs fill a critical niche in the world water crisis—helping communities with available but contaminated water to obtain a clean water supply.”

The Christ Church LWW Mission Team is planning to travel to Peru in January 2018 to install a water purification system in the community of Santo Thomas, on the Rio Orosa, a tributary of the Amazon River. It will be installed in a medical clinic run by Project Amazonus. Members of the team will be traveling to Oxford, MS, this week to attend training at Clean Water U. Please pray for the team and for our partners in Peru. Donations are currently being collected in the 5-gallon water jugs near the assembled system in Surface Hall.
