### **Worship**

**NURSERY** is provided for children up to 5 years of age during Sunday worship services and special church events. All caregivers are screened and complete child abuse prevention training prior to employment. The Nursery can be found in the front hallway off Surface Hall. Please ask a Host or Usher if you need assistance.

**CHILDREN'S CHURCH** occurs during the 10:00am worship service and is for children age 3 years old through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. The children follow the cross out during the singing of the *Gloria* and return during the welcome and announcements. Mother Becca and Father Steve are alternating teaching at this time.

**THE CHILDREN'S WORSHIP PACKETS** contain activity sheets and crayons/colored pencils for children to use during worship. They are located beside the stairs to the Sacristy in Surface Hall just outside the Nave. Please return them after the service.

**THE CHILDREN'S QUIET BOOKS** are handmade, felt and laminated books for use by children during worship services and can be found on a rack in Surface Hall. Parents and kids are encouraged to use these books during services. We ask that they be used gently and returned at the end of each service.
