First off, I want to say thanks for your desire to help shape the lives of our youth! If you're reading this than you're interested in joining our volunteer team. There are lots of areas for you to use your gifts to help out our student ministry. The main way people get involved is by being a lead or assistant small group for our Wednesday night small groups. We are also looking for people who want to help in other areas, like welcome table, administrative volunteer, and security.

To be up front about volunteering with students as a small group leader you need to know a couple things.

1. Leading a small group with students is a commitment. Our students need consistent adults who can speak into their life and point them to Jesus. If showing up on time, and not being able to come regularly are issues for you, then this is not the ministry for you. We ask our adult volunteers to attend Wednesday Night Small Groups about 10-15 times each semester, and attend our Sunday morning meeting at 11am at least twice a month.

2. Leading a small group with students is so rewarding. I hope your main motivation to help is not for what you get out of it, but you will get so much out of it. Building relationships with students and walking through life mentoring them will help you grow so much in your own walk with Jesus. I have been so blessed by the relationships and friendships I have built by working with students for the last 12 years.

3. Leading a small group with students is a lot of fun! Shhh... don't tell anyone, the best kept secret in the church is that the youth volunteers have the most fun. We play crazy games, watch stupid silly videos, eat junk food, and laugh all the time. If you are young or even better young at heart, this is the ministry for you. I won't even get started about the camps and trips you get to go on to at no cost as a volunteer.
