Thirty Days of Prayer for our Schools, Students, and Teachers

15. Sunday, August 17

Bless drivers not only on daily routes but also during field trips and athletic events. We ask this in Jesus Name, Amen!

19. Thursday, August 21

Lord Jesus, we thank you for the fun of sports and the formative role they play in our schools. Use these events to build character and respect in our children. Do not let the children get caught up in elitism and competitive attitudes that are unhealthy. Keep pride and idolatry far from these fields of play. Keep all participants safe and healthy, in Jesus Name we pray, Amen!

20. Friday, August 22

Father, today we repent over our actions that have shut down prayer and the reading of your Word in our public schools. Forgive us as a nation for thinking that You have no place in our educational forums. Forgive our drift away from the Judeo-Christian principles that established our nation. May we humble ourselves, and pray until your influence is felt and welcomed once again in our schools. Prevent hostile philosophies from gaining footholds in our children. We ask this in Jesus' Name, Amen!

21. Saturday, August 23

We ask for administrators to be given wisdom to do what is right.
