- 1. Passion for God**—"Lord, please instill in my children a soul that 'follows hard after You,' one that clings passionately to You." Psalm 63:8
- 2. Love for God's Word**—"May my children grow to find Your Word more precious than much pure gold and sweeter than honey from the comb." Psalm 19:10
- 3. Prayerfulness**—"Grant, Lord, that my children's lives may be marked by prayerfulness, that they may learn to pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers." 1 Thessalonians 5:17
- 4. Love**—"Grant, Lord, that my children may learn to live a life of love, through the Spirit who dwells in them." Galatians 5:25; Ephesians 5:2
- 5. Self-Control**—"Father, help my children not to be like many others around them, but let them be alert and self-controlled in all they do." 1 Thessalonians 5:6
- 6. Purity**—"Create in them a pure heart, O God, and let that purity of heart be shown in their actions." Psalm 51:10
- 7. A Servant's Heart**—"God, please help my children develop servant's hearts, that they may serve wholeheartedly, as if they were serving the Lord, not men." Ephesians 6:7
