10 Ways to Pray for the Persecuted Church

- Pray they will sense God's presence.
 Hebrews 13:5 God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."
- Pray they will experience God's comfort.
 Thessalonians 2:16-17 May our Lord Jesus Christ himself and God our Father, who loved us and by his grace gave us eternal encouragement and good hope, ¹⁷ encourage your hearts and strengthen you in every good deed and word.
- Pray they will see God open doors to evangelism.
 Colossians 4:3 And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains.
- Pray they will continue to boldly share the gospel.
 Acts 4:29 Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness.
- Pray they will forgive and love their persecutors.
 Matthew 5:44, 45 But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you ⁴⁵ that you may be children of your Father in heaven
- Pray they will know we are praying for them.
 Timothy 1:3 I thank God, whom I serve, as my ancestors did, with a clear conscience, as night and day I constantly remember you in my prayers.

- 7. Pray they will be granted wisdom in covert ministry work. **Acts 9:23-25** After many days had gone by, there was a conspiracy among the Jews to kill him, ²⁴ but Saul learned of their plan. Day and night they kept close watch on the city gates in order to kill him. ²⁵ But his followers took him by night and lowered him in a basket through an opening in the wall.
- Pray they will remain joyful amid suffering.
 Acts 5:41 The apostles left the Sanhedrin, rejoicing because they had been counted worthy of suffering disgrace for the Name.
- Pray they will mature in their faith.
 Colossians 1:28-29 He is the one we proclaim, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone fully mature in Christ. ²⁹ To this end I strenuously contend with all the energy Christ so powerfully works in me.
- Pray they will be rooted in God's Word.
 2 Timothy 3:16-17 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, ¹⁷ so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
