# Coming up on 8/11/2019...

## THE PROPHET JEREMIAH

ABOUT SEVENTY-FIVE YEARS after Isaiah had warned Judah to turn back to God or be punished, God called Jeremiah. He was also to warn the people of Judah (the southern kingdom) to turn from their sin of worshiping idols.

At God's instruction, Jeremiah went to the house where a potter made clay pots. He watched the potter shape the pot, but there was a flaw in it. So the potter reformed the clay into another pot that was more sustainable to him. God's message to Jeremiah was that just as the potter could reshape the flawed pot, God could reshape Judah if they would let Him by turning from their idol worship to Him.

God told Jeremiah to go buy a clay pot and take it to tell God's message to the people of Judah. Jeremiah obeyed. He told the people that God was going to bring a terrible disaster on them if they did not repent of their idol worship and sin and turn to Him.

Then Jeremiah broke the pot he had bought. He told them that God said just as Jeremiah broke the pot and it could not be repaired, God would break the nation of Judah. Many people would die; everyone would suffer when conquered by enemies.

Jeremiah's message was clearly understood. The people had a choice. They could obey God and He would bless them, or they could be broken like the clay pot. God loved His people. He wanted them to do right and be blessed. He gave them the choice. They chose to continue in sin and were conquered by their enemies.

## God's Word for each day of the week:

Mon: READ: Isaiah 6:1-4. DISCUSS: How is God being described in this passage? What does it mean for God to be Holy? PRAY: Thank you, God, for being holy and powerful. I'm glad I can serve you.

<u>Tues:</u> READ: Isaiah 6:5. DISCUSS: How did Isaiah feel after seeing God? How would you feel standing in God's presence? PRAY: God, I'm sorry for my sins. I need you to help me to live a life that pleases you.

<u>Wed:</u> READ: Isaiah 6:6-7. DISCUSS: What did the seraph do to Isaiah? What did the Seraph say? What do you have to do to get forgiveness from God? PRAY: Thank you, God, for forgiving my sins so I don't have to feel guilty anymore.

<u>Thurs:</u> READ: Isaiah 6:8. DISCUSS: What did God ask Isaiah? What was Isaiah's response? How would you respond to God in this situation? Why? PRAY: Dear God, I want to do your will even if it is hard. Give me the strength to live for you.

<u>Fri:</u> READ: Isaiah 44:21-22. DISCUSS: What does God say in this passage? What must you do to receive God's forgiveness? PRAY: Dear God, thank you for forgiving me when I ask you to. You are kind and loving.

<u>Sat:</u> READ: Isaiah 44:23. DISCUSS: How should you respond to God's forgiveness? What is something God has forgiven you for? PRAY: You are a mighty God. I praise you for your power to forgive my sins. I love you.
