### EVERYONE NEEDS THE BIBLE

**JOSIAH WAS ONLY EIGHT** years old when he became king of Judah. He inherited the kingdom from his father, Amon.

At the age of twenty-six, Josiah was having the temple of the Lord repaired. During the repairs, the high priest found the Book of the Law which had been lost for many years.

When the Book was read to King Josiah, he learned about how God hates idol worship. His nation had sinned against God in this practice. Josiah tore his robes. (This meant that he was very upset about what the Book showed him.)

Josiah told the priest to ask the Lord what the Book said. A prophetess named Hulduh told them that God promised judgment on the people of Judah because of their idol worship.

Josiah brought all the people together and read the Book of the Law to them. King Josiah then promised God that he and the people of Judah would serve only God and obey His commands. Josiah had seen his sin and repented. The people promised they would obey God's laws too.

King Josiah ordered that all false gods and idols be torn down. They were burned outside the city. King Josiah ordered that all of the unholy things be removed from the temple of the Lord. Then King Josiah went from city to city and tore down altars and shrines and idols of other gods. He removed the spiritists and mediums and got rid of the priests who led the people in worshipping false gods.

Josiah returned to Jerusalem and told the people to celebrate the Passover to the Lord as it was written in the Book. Passover had not been celebrated for many years. In the history of Judah, there was no other king who turned whole heartedly to the Lord as Josiah did.

God's Word revealed the sins of the nation so all the people could repent and turn back to God. The Bible still reveals our sins today. (Romans 3:20) It shows our sin and tells us how to live for God and worship Him. The Bible still has power to change lives.
