Our longtime supported missionary, Joe Szabo, is here today to share with us his heart for people and the ministry he and his wife, Noemi, are involved in. Beginning in 1990, the Szabos faithfully served in Spain for fourteen years planting churches in both the Canary Islands and Madrid. Following this in 2005 until recently, Joe began teaching and preaching at Global University, as well as overseeing their Global Operations division.
