Lord, I hear you. You can work mightily in the heart of anyone who has never even heard of your ways. I believe you when you say that this blessing can be for our company .

The Egyptians pursued them, and all Pharaoh's horses and chariots and horsemen followed them into the sea. Exodus 14:23
