## Read John 10:14-18

- 5. What do you think it means that the Good Shepherd knows his sheep and the sheep know the Good Shepherd? What does it mean to hear the Shepherd's voice?
- 6. How is that distinction different than other perspectives of faith in God?
- 7. Read Psalm 23...what are ways that the Lord cares for the sheep in this passage? List the ways you see the Shepherd caring for the sheep...
- 8. Jesus says several times that the Good Shepherd lays down his life for his sheep, what does that mean to you?
- 9. Was Jesus forced to do this?
- 10. Who are the sheep that are from another pen?
