**Alpha begins Wednesday, September 12<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 p.m. with the Celebration Dinner!** Alpha is a series for anyone who wants a more in-depth understanding of the foundations of the Christian faith—people with questions, people interested in joining Christ The King, or if you want to invite someone who has questions. ***I encourage everyone to come out for this first meeting and see if Alpha is a place for you to grow in your faith.*** Dinner will be at 5:30 p.m. We will have the Alpha presentation following at around 6:00 p.m. (kids can go with Jenny for Kids Club and King's Kids), and the whole thing is done no later than 7:30 p.m. This series will meet every Wednesday at 5:30 p.m. for the next eight weeks to follow, dinner each night and will be taught by Pastor Kenneth and myself.

**Soul Shift series begins the weekend of September 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup>.** Soul Shift is about the transformation God brings to our lives as we put into practice the “Soul Shifts” in His word. Like moving from Me to We thinking, or from Consumer to Steward. ***This eight week series will bring us into a deeper understanding of God's purposes for our lives as the body of Christ.*** It's a great follow-up on our Bearing Fruit series which we just finished this summer. Small groups will then meet during the week, both at church and in homes. We will meet Sunday mornings at 9:30 a.m., Sunday evenings at 6:00 p.m., and Wednesday mornings at 10:00 a.m. here on the church campus. I encourage you to get connected in one these groups, or talk to Allen about home groups meeting throughout the week.

## Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



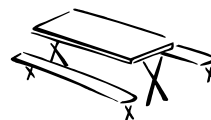

## **NEW FALL SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASSES**

**9:30-10:15 a.m.**

## COME JOIN THE MUSIC!

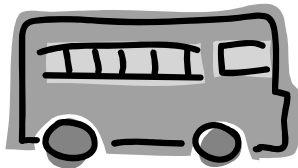

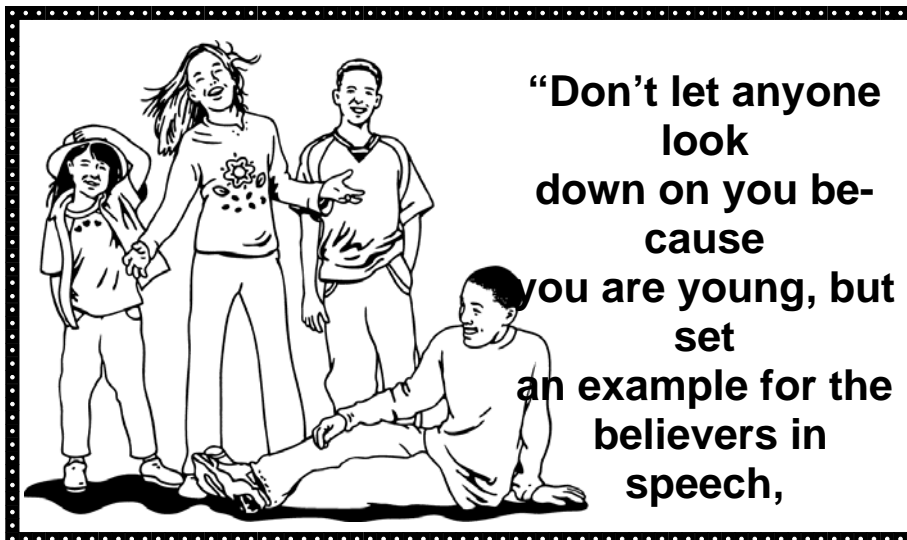
