I would also like to thank everyone who came to conferences, and a BIG thank you to everyone who helped with snacks and drinks for those couple of long days! Your kindness just overflows!

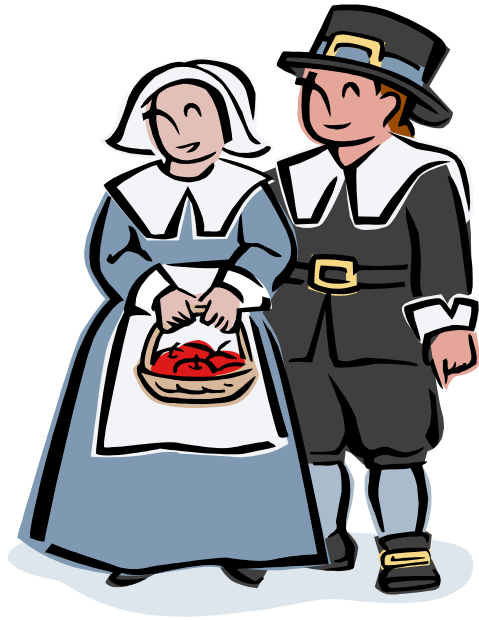
