A.C.T.S. WOMEN'S GROUP

Our parish is beginning an interesting and worthwhile project. We would like to introduce you to the **Malawi Project**: This project involves collecting prescription bottles (only) for the country of Malawi in Africa. Previously used prescription bottles are collected they are then forwarded to an address in Indianapolis, Indiana who in turn forwards the bottles in large shipping containers to clinics in Malawi, Africa and now other parts of the continent. The clinics in Africa use the bottles for their patients to take medication home. At this point in time, their medication is placed in paper wrappers and the patients usually lose it or their children find the pills, ingest them, and this sometimes leads to a child's death. Since the prescription bottles are not able to be recycled, this is a wonderful project to rid our landfills of these items.

There is a bright orange container in the Cloister Connector "Café" clearly marked for collection of these prescription bottles, **ONLY**, no aspirin or vitamin bottles will be accepted. Please also remove the labels and rinse them out before donating. The container will be emptied weekly and the contents sent on to Indiana for shipment to Malawi, Africa.
