The Easter season is upon us. Hopefully, many of you are participating in the Lenten Longings groups. I'm enjoying the discussions about the upcoming readings and the reflections from the people in our group.

Father Andrew and I met to go over the approaching schedule and we decided that it might be best if we no longer introduced ourselves when we are the commentator. Some people are comfortable doing it, others aren't, and so for consistency, will drop the personal introductions. We've had some nice new introductions to read and from now on, we should just read what is written. I've seen a lot more enthusiasm coming from the commentators when they welcome people. Keep it up! First impressions for newcomers are so important. And don't forget to SMILE!

I am once again going to implore you to slow down your pace when you reading. Please read it out-loud to someone and ask him or her to critique you. They should tell you that you are reading too slowly - and if they do - you are probably reading just right. Remember that people need time to digest what you are saying since most aren't looking at the printed word. I know that nerves sometimes get the best of us, causing us to speed up, but if you practice it enough and are comfortable with it, it should be easier to slow down.

It bears repeating that the commentator should be prepared to step in as a reader in the event that one of the readers doesn't show up. We've had a few "no shows" lately. Please, please check the schedule over carefully and find a replacement if you are unable to fulfill an assignment. If you find that you suddenly are unable to attend mass on the day you are scheduled to read, please call one person who attends that mass to let them know. They can then let the deacon know that you won't be there. Everyone should be arriving at least 15 minutes before mass begins. If an assigned reader is not there 10 minutes before mass, alert the deacon and help him to start looking for a replacement for the commentator. The commentator will fill in for the missing reader.

The schedule for Palm Sunday and the Triduum are included in this schedule. I was overwhelmed with how many of you volunteered to participate during that time. Thank you so much! It is imperative that you attend the rehearsals. I have tried to make this as painless as possible since most of us know what to do and how to do it. You need to be there so the sound technicians hear the volume of your voice and can make notes on what volume to set YOUR microphone on when you read your part in the Passion. If you are scheduled to read the Passion on Palm Sunday or on Good Friday, please clear your calendar and make every effort to attend on April 4<sup>th</sup>. The schedule appears along with the reading assignments for Palm Sunday and Good Friday.

May you and your family be blessed as you celebrate the true meaning of Easter, from the reflection of Good Friday to the joy of the resurrection on Easter Sunday that brings the promise of eternal life.
