A safe and successful church event is dependent upon the cooperation and trust of all those participating in it. The following code includes, but is not limited to, behaviors designed to ensure a good experience for all of us. We covenant with each other to abide by this code ourselves and to hold one another accountable to it as well.

During this program/trip/event, I will . . .

- *Maintain an attitude of generosity (a “hermeneutic of generosity”) toward others: assuming their good will toward me and responding with good will toward them*
- *Maintain a spirit of community and faithful witness to the Gospel*
- *Keep what is said confidential unless someone is at risk of harm*
- *Join in group activities without complaint or competitiveness*
- *Refrain from put-downs, belittling or aggressive comments, or dramatic outbursts*
- *Not use vulgar, discriminatory, or sexual language*
- *Not put anyone, including myself, in an uncomfortable or potentially vulnerable position*
- *Respect boundaries regarding touch, familiarity, and intimacy*
- *Hold myself and others accountable to this code.*
