II. Changing my conduct begins by changing myMIND
"Therefore, preparing your minds for action, and being sober-minded" 1 Peter 1:13a ESV

A - Focusing all myHOPE upon God's futureGRACE

B - Remembering my <u>CONDUCT</u> will be subject to God's <u>JUDGMENT</u> .
"Remember that the heavenly Father to whom you pray has no favorites. He will judge or reward you according to what you do. So you must <u>live in reverent fear of him</u> during your time here as 'temporary residents.'" 1 Peter 1:17 NLT
