# This week in....



#### Bible

This week we will be talking about the Easter story. Because of our short week we will not be working on a specific verse or having a Bible quiz.



## Reading

We will be finishing Charlotte's Web, Trumpet of the Swan, and Stuart Little mid-week. The students will be discussing the last few chapters on Tuesday and Wednesday, then we will watch the movie version of Charlotte's Web and compare/contrast the movie, book, and theater versions of the story.
