What We've Been Learning

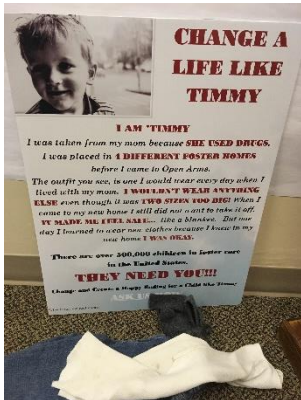
