Friday, May 17th

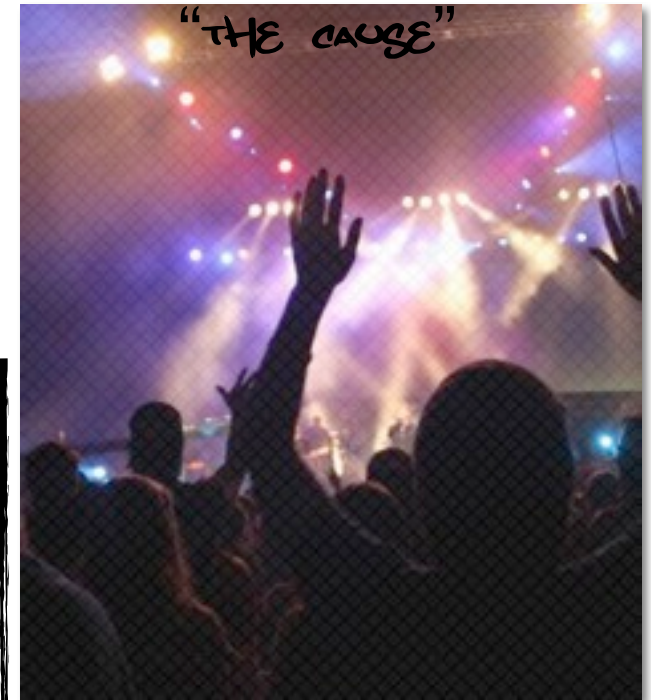
9:00 am - Meet at the church to board the bus, catching the I am ferry.

Registration:

This year, I have **35 spaces available**. Students who are regular attenders of Glow will have higher priority than those who have not attended consistently in the past year.

To ensure your spot on the trip, you must pay a \$60 dollar deposit. This essentially covers the Conference registration. The remainder of the trip is \$170

Praise God! It's cheaper than last year. Why?

The cost reflects: Bus rental, Ferries, Registration, Accommodation, and a slight amount extra so that we can bring our room leaders at little cost to them. This year we have our own bus driver, and were able to obtain super early bird tickets at a significant discount.

Remember to bring money for food. I recommend you budget for 9 meals plus snacks.
