Dear CCS Supporter,

We want to update you on the exciting plans for CCS becoming an “independent” community Christian school. We also ask that you prayerfully consider being a part of the capital campaign to purchase our own facility.

Our Objective: Transition to an independent, community, Christian school not controlled by any one church or denomination; and moving the school to its own dedicated school building, debt-free by the beginning of the 2013-2014 school year.

The Background: CCS Established in 1978 by the 1st E-Free Church of Fort Dodge

- Celebrating 35 years of service this year!
- Not intended to be limited to any single church or denomination.
- 18 churches are represented in current student enrollment.
- However, prevalent perception is that the school is tied to the church and church attendance.
- Accordingly, parents often do not consider CCS as an educational option for their family.

Our Goals:

- Governance by an Association composed of member families, businesses, and churches.
- School Board elected by the Association
- Expand community awareness and financial support.
- Increase student enrollment.

The Capital Campaign:

- \$405,000 required to acquire “new” facility and transition to independent status.
- Purchase the former Holy Rosary School located at 2406 9-1/2 Avenue South, Fort Dodge.
- Raise funds to complete purchase and initial building improvements by August 1, 2013.
