The Methodist Mission in the Village of Hanwa currently has no fresh water or electricity available to its hundreds of primary and secondary school students and staff. This is the Mission where we previously helped to build several primary and secondary school blocks.

We have committed to raise the necessary funds to complete the drilling of a deep borehole, the installation of a pump and holding tank and the connection of electricity to the well and to the entire Mission.

The ability to obtain fresh water and electricity will significantly enhance the health conditions and the overall teaching environment of this very rural village.
