1. Share about a time you had a personal crisis of faith. How was it pivotal in your life? How were you different after that crisis of faith?

- 2. Terry shared several challenges to living with 'risk' (*security, safety, minimal involvement, lack of faith, fear, routine, insecurity, etc.*). Which of those challenges do you most struggle with? What can you do to overcome those challenges and live more 'risky'? Pray for one another in these areas!
- 3. On the other side, are you a 'risk junky'? Do you need to confess this as sin and just be faithful to what God has called you to do each day (instead of trying to do the risky and dangerous just because you like it)?
- 4. Within your group, share testimonies of God's faith in your lives. Develop your own "Cornerstone Community Group Hall of Faith"!
- 5. Here is a good question to ask yourself each night before you fall asleep: What did I do today that required faith? You might even try asking it in your group if you have an evening group!
