1. In Revelation 13:8, we are told of a “book of life of the Lamb who was slain,” which has names that were written in it “before the foundation of the world.” This means that there was a plan in place to rescue a people by the blood of the Lamb long before there were people in need of rescue from their rebellion. Discuss your thoughts on this as a group. What does this mean? What other questions does this bring up? Don’t be in a hurry to move past this idea.
 2. How does it make you feel to know that as followers of Jesus we are a “love gift”, as Todd put it, between the Father and the Son?
 3. This text describes people who will worship the beast (or, really the dragon!). What does this mean? What are ways that people may even be doing this now? Is this something that you or others may be doing? Why is this such an affront to God?
 4. When Todd said that confidence in your salvation comes from seeing “fruit” in your life, what did you think? Can you identify other passages of Scripture that suggest the same thing? Discuss this.
