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1. Have there been times in your life when you were tempted to turn your back on Jesus? If so, share with your group about those times; share why the temptation to throw in the towel was so strong, and why you didn't. If there haven't been those times, share what kept you following Jesus when the valley of life was so dark.
 2. Life's trials can be so daily, even hourly. How in the world can some future return of Jesus in total victory give us the hope to get through a hard day or week or season of life? Talk about this! How can you take this future victorious triumph of King Jesus into your life, and let it give you hope in the next days or weeks?
 3. Discuss your understanding of God's wrath. How did Chris's explanation help you understand it better? What other questions do you have about the wrath of God? Discuss these together and see if you can find some answers. Use a good theology book such as *Systematic Theology* by Wayne Grudem or *Christian Theology* by Millard Erickson to do more research.
 4. Discuss Rev 16:15 and expand your thoughts on what this 'warning/blessing' means. Discuss ways you do what this verse says, or don't do what it says. What do you think the 'blessing' is for those who follow Jesus' warning?
 5. If you want to study further, here are several other passages that give insight to these chapters in Revelation: Matt 24:36-51; Matt 25:13; Rom 1:18-25; 1 Thess 5:1-11.
