PASSPORT

A valid US Passport is essential for all International Mission Trips/Travel. Please allow ample time as you apply for your passport. Routine applications are currently being processed in **approximately 4-6 weeks** from the time of application.

To obtain a passport for the first time, or to renew your passport:
