GAMES LEADER:

Volunteer who is 16 years old and above who can arrive by 5:30 p.m. This person will plan and lead students in fun games/activities that lasts for 30 minutes.

SERVING DINNER:

Volunteer who will pick up the food prepared by the Café and take it to the students, serve it, clean up and when they are finished return the cart to the Café.
