STATEMENT OF BELIEFS

We believe the Bible is the inspired Word of God in which we base our beliefs, our faith, and our conduct upon.

We believe that Jesus Christ died on a cross and shed his blood to justify us from our sins. Our salvation comes by grace alone through faith in the finished work on the cross. Mankind's only hope of redemption from our fallen state comes through the shed blood of Jesus.

We believe in one GOD who exists in three persons; the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost.

We believe unequivocally in the Deity of our Lord Jesus Christ; Jesus being both fully man and fully God.

We believe in the baptism of the Holy Ghost being a separate work apart from salvation for the empowering of the believer for the work of the ministry. We affirm that all believers receive the Holy Ghost upon salvation but that there is a separate event outlined in scripture called the Baptism of the Holy Ghost.
