INTRODUCTION

Life can be hard, enemies will attack you, the shadow of death can come but David tells us that we don't need to fear, to not lose heart, and to keep singing; because *God is with us, He is for us, He never leaves us, and He has promised to bless us.*

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Talk about a time where God blessed you. How did you know that it was God blessing you and not just "good fortune"?
2. Has there ever been a time when you prayed and God answered your prayer in a way that was totally unexpected? How did this affect your faith?
3. In the message Jon said that God has called all of us to something we can't do on our own. Is there something that you feel God has called you to but have been afraid to tell others because you realize it's impossible?
4. In [Psalm 115:12-13](#) David said that God promises to bless those who fear Him? What do you think David means when he says "fear God"? Do you find it difficult to believe that God wants to bless you? Why or Why not?
5. What are some great things God has done for you in your life?
6. Is there something in your life that you have been needing to hear from God on? How could this group help you receive God's best?
