Discussion Questions

There is no doubt when we study what the scriptures reveal about the early days of the Church that the key to their powerful influence in the world was the unity of their passion to celebrate and share the wonderful news about Jesus life, death and resurrection. They relied on the Holy Spirit living in them to guide them to truth which strengthened their unity and empowered them to be bold in sharing their faith with family, friends and others in the community.

This week our bottom line is two-fold, Celebrate with our Church community the Gospel message through the communion time and secondly accept the challenge to be in unity with the Spirit and each other in sharing our faith with those around us.

Discussion Questions

- 1. What are we celebrating at a Communion Service?
- 2. How do we make it personal?
- 3. What does it mean to examine ourselves? (I Corinthians 11:28) Condemnation?
- 4. Is our Faith a true celebration or something we seem to painfully endure? If we just painfully endure it, we are not likely to share it.
- 5. Do you feel a sense of community (Unity) with other believers?
- 6. Specifically name some people you will seek to invite on Easter to hear the Great News about what Jesus Christ has done for all of us. Everyone is forgiven, but not everyone is yet reconciled.

Let's all be unified in and with the community of believers where God has placed us (Crosspointe Church or whatever Church you serve at) and pray for the Spirit to fill us and lead us to those around us (Family, Friends, etc.) who are hungry for the great news about our risen savior.
