

Week 5 - What Makes You Wise

## INTRODUCTION

Most all of us would like to think we are wise; especially when you consider "being a fool" is the alternative. In Proverbs, God used Solomon to give a very short exam that anyone can take to grade whether or not their life is one living in wisdom or being expended on foolishness.

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1. If someone were to ask you if you were wise, what would be your answer?
- 2. What are some things that you believe make a person wise?
- 3. Read <u>Proverbs 11:30</u>. What does Solomon say makes a person wise? Read <u>John 15:1-14</u>. In verse 13, what does Jesus say we will do when our life is producing righteous fruit? What do you think Jesus means when He says: "*lay down your life for your friends*"?
- 4. Jon said, "When we give our life to help others find their life in Christ, we are wise." What are some of the ways you are giving (laying down) your life so that others are being directed towards finding their life in Christ?
- 5. Jon challenged us to take a step with God, ourselves, and others by making some commitments for Easter Sunday. He asked everyone to pick a service time, set a personal goal of visitors that you would like to see attending with you, and pray for and invite guest to be with you on that Sunday. Please share the steps you took in following this challenge.

## **MOVING FORWARD**

Proverbs 11:30 affirms that when we give our life to help others find their life in Christ, we are wise. Easter Sunday is coming and Crosspointe Church has made plans to make it as simple as possible for you to invite the individuals you have been investing in or those God brings across your path, so that they can find their life in Christ.
