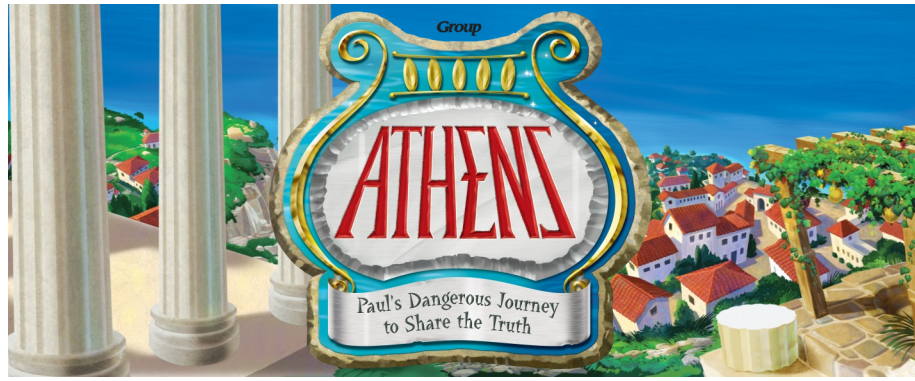
FINANCIAL REPORT FOR FEBRUARY 2013

- Tithes and offerings for February were \$44,760.87, while expenses were \$55,715.55 resulting in a deficit for the month of \$10,954.68.
- Through February, tithes and offerings for the year are \$85,903.82, while expenses are \$110,025.81, resulting in a deficit of \$24,121.99. Tithes and offerings have averaged \$42,951.91 while all expenses averaged \$55,012.90.
- Tithes and offerings for 2013 have equaled \$85,903.82. They equaled \$129,948.96 during 2012 for the same time period. Tithes and offerings for 2013 are \$44,045.14 less than 2012.
