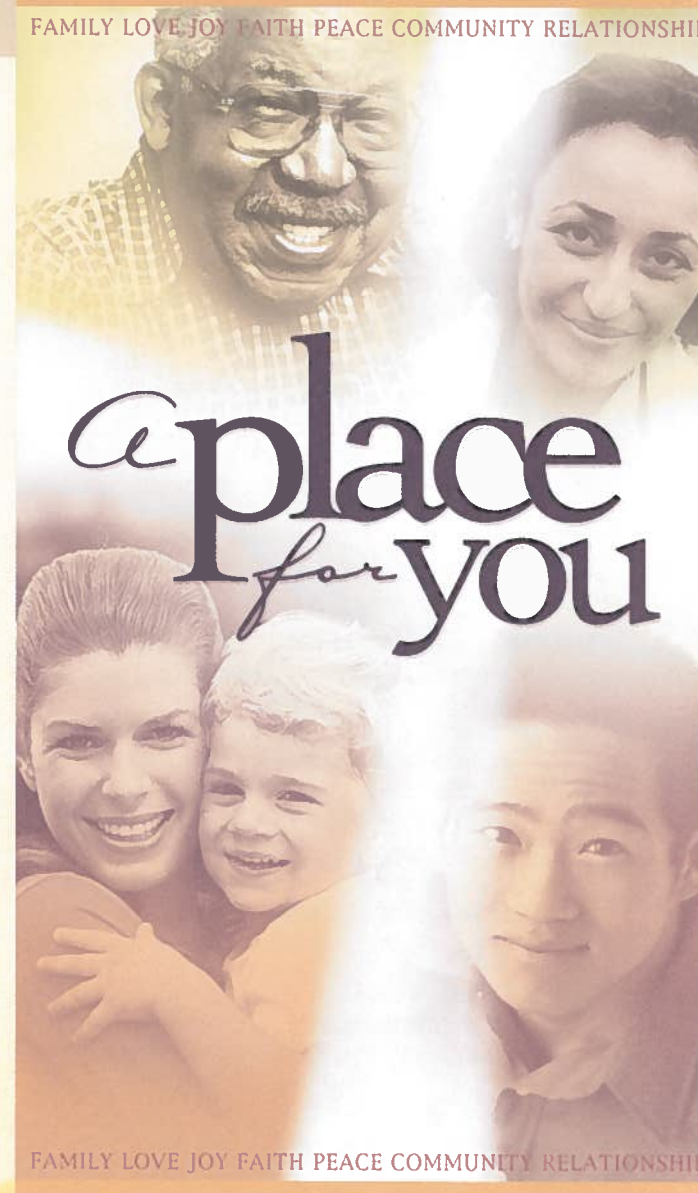

Sunday Morning Bible Study

Ladies Peace Class (Medium) Room V113

This group is made up of women of mixed ages and backgrounds: married, single, career, stay-at-home moms, with/without children.

Parents of Faith (Medium) Room F112

This class offers parents the opportunity to study the Bible together. Bible teaching responsibilities are shared with several teachers.

Living R.E.A.L. (Small) Fellowship Hall 4

Real People Excited About Loving God is our newest young to median adult class. Bible teaching responsibilities are shared with several teachers.

Redeemer Class (Medium) Fellowship Hall 2

Many of the members of this class have children ranging in age from toddler to teenager. Bible teaching responsibilities are shared between several teachers. Its relaxed teaching format leads to open discussion.

Growth Class (Small) Fellowship Hall 3

This class examines the Bible in the context in which it was written. Provocative questions are explored to challenge our thinking and develop a 21st century application for our lives.

College/Career/Singles Class (Small) V116

This class draws in young adults with a sense of community and relevant Bible study.

Disciples Class (Small) Room V117

Open discussion, sharing of prayer needs, and application of biblical truths are components of this class.

Berean Bible Class (Small) Room V112

This class studies the Bible verse by verse, one book at a time, alternating between the Old and New Testaments. They have great fellowship.

Aquila/Priscilla Class (Large) Worship Center

This coed class, although large in number, takes the time to be involved in each other's lives on a personal level. Biblical learning includes lecture and class discussion.

Fellowship Class (Large) Fellowship Hall 1 starts at 9:00 a.m.

The Fellowship class is a loving, caring, and nurturing coed group made up of mostly senior adults (but all ages are welcome to join the fun).
