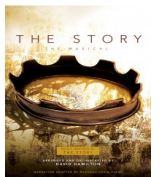
**Tickets must be bought TODAY in the Lobby

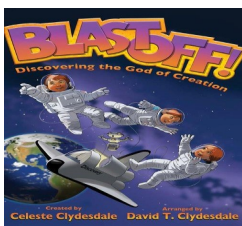
