Purpose:

Our ministry exists to provide a safe environment in which students and their families can grow in their relationship with Christ as well as have fun in fellowship. Our Goal is to win new believers to Christ, while helping our current body of members to grow in spiritual maturity, thus enabling them to effectively minister to others.

How We Accomplish The Purpose:

We Reach Up by worshipping our one true God. We express our love and devotion to him through worship. All of us are wired to worship, and the only way we can truly express our love to God is through a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. We Reach Out through various mission projects, service projects, and outreach events targeted at reaching people who exist outside of the local church. By doing this we fulfill the great command: "therefore go and make disciples of all nations baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." Matthew 28:19

We Reach In by helping our members grow in spiritual maturity. We are focused on teaching people how to apply Biblical truths to every aspect of their lives. By helping them grow deeper spiritually we enable them to become more effective ministers to others.

Levels of Ministry:

Brickhouse – Sunday Night Weekly Gathering (Mass Event)

Our Sunday night service exists to reach out to the community. BH Sunday Night offers a variety of events in which common ground can be reached with all community students as well as those who come on a regular basis. Sunday Nights provide an opportunity to share the gospel message and a time for fellowship/games. This is where students can hangout with friends, play active sports games, video games, and learn. Youth Coaches are at this event interacting with students.

Sunday Morning – Weekly Gathering In Adult Services (Crowd Event)

After students have entered the ministry through the “front doors” of our ministry (Brickhouse Sunday Night), we encourage them to attend Sunday morning services. This is where students can hear the word of God, spend time in worship, and have fun in fellowship.

Small Groups (Discipleship)

Once students have entered the “front doors” of the ministry (Brickhouse) and have been engaged in Sunday Morning worship they move on to the next level of ministry, small groups. In small groups students will be challenged, transformed, and taught deeper biblical truths. Students will learn what a disciple truly is. Meeting on a consistent basis is key to spiritual development. Small groups can be either student lead or adult lead. Some examples of this ministry would be Fight Club and Girls Bible Study.

Student Leadership (Leadership)

This ministry focuses on helping students grow in leadership. This ministry seeks out and prepares leaders for our church and community. Students will be able to understand how to be a leader and a laborer with events such as leading small groups, miGroups (airsoft, nerf wars), games, retreat, mission projects, etc.
