Nursery Hours

Nursery opens 10 minutes before church services begin. Latecomers should ring the nursery door bell to call an attendant to nursery registration. Parents are asked to return promptly to pick up children after services conclude.

Check-In

When your child arrives in the nursery, your child, diaper bag, and any bottle, cups or blankets will be labeled with your child's name and pager number. This helps us to ensure personal attention and sanitary care.

Pagers

Upon entering the nursery you will receive a numbered paging unit that corresponds to your child's number. Please place this paging unit on a belt or garment as they are vibrating units. This is an easy way to notify you if your child should need you during the service. If your pager is activated, please go immediately to the nursery.

Facilities

We try hard to provide a safe and clean environment for your child. We provide:

- Safe disinfectant spray for toys
- First Aid kits in both rooms
- Security measures, tags & pagers
- Age-appropriate toys/equipment



Illness Policy

We are concerned for the safety and health of every child. We ask that you do not bring your child to our nursery if one or more of the following symptoms are present:

- Unusual fatigue or irritability
- Excessive coughing, sneezing, or runny nose
- Fever of 101 degrees or higher within 24hrs
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- Inflamed mouth or throat
- Impetigo
- Conjunctivitis (pink eye)

Should any of the above symptoms be detected in your child, the Service Host will ask you not to bring your child into the nursery.

If your child is being treated with antibiotics, he or she should be on the drug for at least 24 hours before coming into our nursery. If your child is taking any form of medication, please administer it prior to check-in. We are not permitted to administer any medication except an Epi-Pen for an allergic reaction.

If your child has been exposed to a childhood disease, please do not place him or her in the nursery until the incubation or contagious period has expired. (Chicken pox, measles, etc.)

Diaper Changing

We recommend that you include a spare diaper in your child's bag. If your child is changed during the service, we tag him/her with a diaper changing sticker. If you would like to be paged if your child needs to be changed, please notify us at check-in.

Snacks/Allergies

Due to allergies, please do not bring any snacks into our area, and finish all food prior to entering. Medical/Allergy/Security tags are available at check-in if needed.

Check-Out

For the protection of your child, we must receive your paging unit back before releasing your child. If a family member or friend is picking up your child, they must have the pager. Thank you for your cooperation in helping to keep our area safe and secure.

The goal of our program is to provide a loving, healthy, and safe environment for each child while parents attend church services.
