Where Are You Seated Pastor Bobby

The title of Sunday's upcoming message is "Where Are You Seated?" The May series, called "Changing The Atmosphere" sounds like a weather report but it is actually a way of living, either in the fruit of the flesh or the fruit of the spirit. It's a pretty cool and cloudy atmosphere in a home or workplace where the elements of the flesh like sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery, idolatry and witchcraft, hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions and envy, drunkenness, orgies, and the like are present (Gal 5:19-21). It's a clear and sunny day in the atmosphere of the spirit where love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control are evident (Gal 5:22-23). Which environment would you like to grow up in?

Sunday's message will center on changing your "inner atmosphere" so your outer atmosphere can be different. One key understanding in doing this is being reminded where we are seated! Receiving Christ gives us a massive advantage in becoming atmosphere changers. Once Jesus moves in, we move up! Ephesians 2:6 tells us "And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus." Why is the verse so critical for us to grasp in order to change our outer atmosphere? Because where you are seated is where you get your counsel! If you are seated in the midst of the fruit of the flesh, then you will draw your counsel from your problems. But if you are seated in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus you will draw from His counsel and have a different outcome.

I remember a man who worked for Freedom in Christ ministries who told about being called to the witness stand in the trial of a person that he had counseled. The prosecuting attorney was taunting him as a "Christian counselor." The opposing attorney jabbed questions like: "What school did you attend?" "Whoever heard of that one?" "Were they accredited to give you the right to counsel this person?" "You call yourself Christian…" and many other accusations followed. The gentleman said that inwardly his blood began to boil and his anger began to stew. Then suddenly he remembered,

"I'm not seated in this courtroom, absorbing these defaming questions. I'm seated in heaven and I'm God's child! He loves me regardless of this outcome, and He gives me wise counsel at all times."

When the man focused on those realities instead of the accusations coming at him, he calmed down inside and answered the man's questions with peace. Because he chose to focus on where he was seated "within", the atmosphere changed "without."
