



Thanks for coming to Daybreak Church and checking out All Stars Children's Ministry. All Stars meets kids where they are at, and through relationships with coaches, one-on-ones (if needed), other kids, and parents (you), helps kids walk through exploring and discovering a life-changing journey with Jesus Christ.

The ultimate goal of All Stars is to help kids know that following Jesus changes their life. Jesus asks His followers to transform their minds (Romans 12:1-2). When kids get involved in the three areas of All Stars ministry, they learn that the Bible has answers to their everyday questions and problems. Using the Bible as a tool for all of life will set a righteous foundation for them in the future.

All Stars takes a child on a journey of spiritual development and growth using three core ministries. **Sunday morning ministries** are designed for kids seeking to know God, who may or may not have made a commitment to accept Jesus Christ as their Savior, **Celebrate** who God is and what He is doing. **Scrimmage (Wednesday nights)** is a fun way to challenge kids who already know Jesus personally to **Connect** with one another and use the truths found in the Bible to learn a specific purpose that God has for their life. All Stars also offers **Kids in Ministry** to help kids identify what their unique **Contribution** in the church could be, and figure out how they can serve others outside of the church. We believe that kids who are involved in all three areas of Children's Ministry and are getting consistently taught by their parents will go far in their journey with and commitment to Jesus. All Stars as a whole must first connect with and resource you: the parents. You have the most influence on your child, so naturally we want to partner with you. Coaches (teachers) are encouraged to talk to you as much as possible, and share what is going on spiritually with your children. 2012-2013 All Stars Core Ministries



Step 1: Celebrate who God is and what He's doing

Ministry: Sunday Morning (Age appropriate classes, JV Overtime, Doubleheader)

Ages: JV (Birth through Kindergarten), Varsity (1st through 4th Grade), and Fusion (5th Grade)

When: Every Sunday morning at 9:00am and 11:00am at all campuses (Fusion 9am only)

Description: Each week kids learn a portion of the Bible and how it relates to their life in a fun large group setting and classroom setting. Kids do an activity to help them remember the lesson and have a discussion time about the lesson. Kids of parents who "sit & serve" go to their normal class at 9:00am, and then to a special class called JV Overtime or Varsity Doubleheader at 11:00am.

Step 2: Connect with others in God's family



Ministry: Scrimmage

Ages: JV2's (2 year olds) through 5th Graders

When: Every Wednesday night 6:15pm-8:00pm in the Fall and Spring at Gettysburg Pike Campus for Daybreak kids from every campus.

September 14, 2011 through December 7, 2011 (no Scrimmage on 11/23/11)

January 9, 2013 through March 27, 2013 (party on April 7, 2013)

Description: Kids go through a handbook all year in a small group that explores one of the five purposes based on the Purpose Driven Life by Rick Warren. They also have fun large group worship, snack, and game time. Purchase a handbook in the resource center at GPC for \$12.00.

Step 3: Contribute by helping others know God

Ministry: Kids in Ministry

Ages:

Kid's Worship Team (both campuses): 1st-5th grade

Kid's Drama Team (both campuses): 3rd-5th grade

When:

Kid's Worship Team: Every other Sunday at 11:00am at GPC and GHR

Kid's Drama Team: Every other Sunday at 11:00am at GPC and GHR. Performances are on some Wednesday nights

Description:

Kid's Worship Team: learn how to be worship leaders by practicing and leading other kids in worship

Kid's Drama Team: uses skits to teach Bible truths to other kids

Ministry: Local & Global Partners

Ages: Kids JV (Birth through Kindergarten), Varsity (1st through 4th Grade), and Fusion (5th Grade)

When: Every Sunday morning and some special events

Description: Kids can give money and items in their classrooms to the following partners:

All Stars Classes @ Gettysburg Pike Campus

Nursery A – Infants to crawler

Nursery is located across from the women's restroom behind the Worship center.

2 Similar JVT Nurseries – Walking Toddlers

First room on the right, behind the worship center.

First room on the left, as you head down the children's wing.

Children in the following classes will follow the "school" schedule. They will move up at the beginning of September, and will follow the age as of September 30. (In other words, a child who turns 2 on March 16 will enter JV2 at the end of August, not when he/she turns 2.)

All of these classes are located in the All Stars children's wing.

JV2 – 2 years (before September 30)

Class is the first room on the left, as you head down the children's wing.

JV3 – 3 years (before September 30)

Class is the second room on the left, as you head down the children's wing.

JV4 – 4 years (before September 30)

Class is the third room on the left, as you head down the children's wing.

JVK – Kindergarten

Class is the last room on the left, as you head down the children's wing.

1st Grade

Class is the second room on the right, after you pass the restrooms.

2nd Grade

Class is the first room on the right, after you pass the restrooms.

3rd Grade

Class is the last room on the right.

4th Grade

Class is the second room on the right.

5th Grade

Class is the last room on the right in the Acoustic Venue.

JV Nursery

Infant & Toddler Nursery – Birth to 2 years old

Babies and toddlers in this class will have a fun time of playing with age appropriate toys, singing and dancing and learning how much God loves them by being shown love and care by our dedicated volunteers.

JV2-3 Class

The JV2-3 class is for children who are ages 2 and 3 and ready to learn about God through music, Bible stories, crafts and games.

JV4-K Class

The JV4-K class is for children who are ages 4, 5 or in Kindergarten and are ready to learn about God through worship, Bible teaching truths, crafts and games.

Varsity

Varsity 1st – 4th Grade

Kids in this class will have a fun time engaging with their peers and teachers and learn how to be a Christ follower at church, home and learn how to apply what they are learning to their everyday lives.

Fusion 5th Grade

Fusion combines elements of Children's Ministry and Student Ministries in order to meet kids right where they are at spiritually and challenge them to take their next step.
