Course Description: Continuing the study of the Christian church from the eleventh century on through the twentieth century. Special attention will be given to the most notable periods like the Renaissance, Reformation and the first and second “Great Awakenings.” We will also heavily consider the development of the modern-day Pentecostal and Charismatic movements.

Assignments: Total points 1000

Classroom Participation: Every student is expected to come to class prepared and contribute to discussions. **100 pts**

Quizzes: At the beginning of each class session, students will answer questions drawn from the previous week’s lecture and reading assignment. The exam will consist of 20 True/False, Multiple-Choice and some fill in the blank questions drawn from the weekly class lectures and weekly reading assignments **200 pts.**

Homework Assignments: The First 10-week students will be given a homework assignment to complete and turn the following class. **200 pts.**

Book Summary: Students will summarize the four parts of the textbook. **Part 1** Due Week 3; **Part 2** Due Week 6; **Part 3** Due Week 9. See paper Rubric for papers specifications. **100 each part. Total 300 pts**

Class Presentation: Everyone is required to participate in their group’s final presentation. **100 pts.**

Reading Log: Each student is expected to keep up with reading assignments. **Point Value 100 pts**

Attendance Policy: In accordance with The Detroit Bible Institute policy all students must attend a minimum of 10 classes in order to receive credit for the course. Excused absences are considered at the discretion of the instructor and will not count against the student. In the event that a student does have an excused absence, the instructor reserves the right to assign extra homework and reading to make up for lecture time missed by student.

Grading Policy: The Detroit Bible Institute employs a letter-grade system. A student must complete a minimum of 75% of all course work (750 points) in order to pass. The instructors at DBI use the following letter grades and their achievement equivalents listed below to reflect a student’s performance in a course. “Incomplete” and “Withdrawal” are recorded appropriately.
