We worked alongside the medical team where 366 people came from the surrounding villages for the top 3 death threatening conditions: malaria, HIV/AIDS and pneumonia (plus a potpourri of other conditions). Some of these folks will live and die and never see a doctor. A cheap penicillin pill can save lives.
